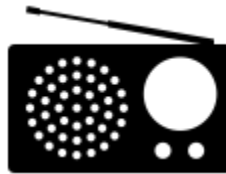

## FUNDRAISING

- Work with each chapter's Gizborit to create a successful program fundraiser each term.
  - Each chapter is different, so working with each Gizborit individually will let us talk and see how big or small we can go!
  - By working with my counterparts, I hope to teach them how to grow their fundraisers. The increase in revenue will allow chapters to focus on other aspects of our order such as programming.
- Encourage chapters to have at least two fundraisers each term.
  - One small and one big fundraiser
- Increase every chapter's fundraising by 25%. By expanding to the community, our customer base increases, generating larger profits. A chapter's stress should never be financial.
- Get the Gizborit involved regionally by having each of them help out at conventions; participating in regional fundraisers.
- Have a Council wide movie night.
- Have a portion of the proceeds of shuk go into fundraising for chapters.
- Keep in touch with other Council Gizborim to make a location for Chapter Gizborim to have resources on how to effectively plan a fundraiser.



## 30TH NORTH CAROLINA COUNCIL

- Work with the council Mazkirah and Safranit to design a website that makes it easy for teens to navigate the shuk catalog.
  - The Safranit will help design the website so it looks sophisticated and easy to use.
  - The Mazkirah will advertise the website so we will be able to get the word out there.

## STANDUP/ INTERNATIONAL SERVICE FUND

- Promote education surrounding ISF
  - Make sure chapters are educating people on what ISF is and how it helps
- Give incentives to donate to ISF
- Increase every chapter's donation to StandUp and Speak Up by 5%
- Increase regional Scholarships.
  - Money should never be a reason to miss a BBYO event.
- Create a canteen at conventions to fundraise for Regional Initiatives (StandUp, SpeakUp, ISF).
- Find new ways to educate the council about ISF
- Create Council tzedakah box to be at all regional/council conventions
- Encourage Chapters to have a tzedakah box to be at weekly programs.
