Whether you are someone who enjoys summer experiences, weekly programs, regional conventions or anything in between, we all do it for a purpose. The enjoyment of having a Jewish community around us that is so inspiring.

Technology is something that has been granted to our generation, so why not use it to our advantage! We can use technology to connect teens from all over the world by using new platforms, such as BBYO on Demand! Getting in touch with our sister city, Zaporozhiha, Ukraine, will open up teens' perspectives on globalization, inspiring them to become more involved and educated. Chapter Gizborim will be able to schedule calls with teens from AJT and do interactive activities like cooking food, learning about cultures, and get to know each other all over 'face' calls. Another way to use technology for the betterment of our council is by making a shuk website. By working with the Council Mazkirah and Safranit to design a website it will make it easy for teens to navigate the shuk catalog.
