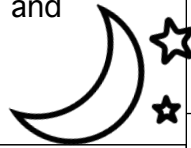


GOALS AND IDEAS



Chapter Counterparts

- ☆ Create resources similar to the AZA and BBG Toolbox resources for counterparts, that include information about everything they need to know for each aspect and ideas
- ☆ Encourage chapter counterparts to enter designs into the International Convention 2022 Shuk
- ☆ Keep in constant contact with all counterparts
- ☆ Will respond within 12 hours to all texts, emails, etc.
- ☆ Have monthly Gizborim calls for check-ins, region updates, and counterpart bonding
- ☆ Serve as a resource and guide for all counterparts



Stand UP and the International Service Fund

- ☆ Lead at least 3 region-wide Stand UP programs throughout the year at conventions or virtually (not during a convention)
 - ★ Reach out to speakers and/or organizations relating to our Stand UP cause
- ☆ Fundraise for the Stand UP cause through shuk or through other Stand UP programs/events
- ☆ ISF Education/ ISF Awareness throughout the region
 - ★ Promotion through conventions/programs at conventions
 - ★ Ensure that every chapter in NCC has some form of ISF education, whether that be holding a program pertaining to ISF or just by informing their chapter about it through social media or speaking about it during a program
- ☆ Hype up ISF to chapters and motivate chapters to donate to ISF throughout the year
- ☆ Promote international initiatives about ISF to the region to promote and encourage ISF
- ☆ Create ISF Grams for in-person conventions during meals - charge \$1 to send a note to someone at the convention and all proceeds will go to ISF
- ☆ Have an ISF and/or Stand UP Tzedakah box at in-person conventions



Globalization

- ☆ Work to bring back Operation: Globalize Eastern (created by the 23rd NCC Gizborim), which is a programming competition focused on Globalization to raise money for ISF
- ☆ Partner chapters that are interested with a chapter outside of the US to do virtual programming together and/or have pen pals
- ☆ Meet up virtually with teens from AJT in Zaporozhye, Ukraine, our sister city
- ☆ Ensure that my chapter counterparts educate their chapter about globalization and its importance and hold at least one globalization program per term

Shuk and Fundraising

- ☆ Work with chapter counterparts to hold one fundraiser every two months, or work with the smaller chapters to find the best timing for the most effective and successful fundraisers
- ☆ Hold a raffle at conventions for Eastern Region/BBYO merchandise and perks for the convention (i.e. late night ice cream)
- ☆ Host speakers or a panel of speakers virtually for an entrance fee to fundraise for our council and/or region
- ☆ Host a council board competition or field day, similar to the International Board's Among Us game to raise money for our council and/or region
- ☆ Create a year-round virtual shuk
 - ★ This would encompass convention shuk, unless we are in-person later in the year
 - ★ Create new, basic Eastern Region designs to sell
- ☆ Create a shuk catalog to send to the region as past Gizborim have done so that participants know how much money to bring to conventions
- ☆ Host designing workshops for chapter counterparts before conventions to learn how to design best-selling items
