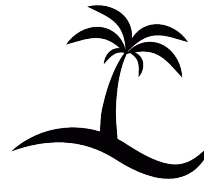

Programming

- ☼ Host monthly engaging workshops for the NCC BBG chapter S'ganim, including topics such as how to incorporate the seven folds into programming, how to budget a program effectively, and the best ways to calendar
- ☼ Help chapters to have at least two programs every month
- ☼ Provide multiple resources to ensure high-quality chapter programming
 - ↪ Programming Monthly Office Hours: allow all chapter NCC BBG S'ganim who need assistance in programming to come
- ☼ Encourage chapters in different cities to work together on one or two programs throughout the year
- ☼ Emphasize the new health fold and how to incorporate it into WOW programming
- ☼ Emphasize the importance of the BBYO International Toolbox
- ☼ Expand the NCC Program Bank and work with the SEC and VAC council S'ganim to expand it to all of Eastern Region

Chair Positions

- ☼ Encourage chapter S'ganim to include an 'Inclusion Chair' or a 'Siblinghood Chair' to make sure that every member feels included within their chapter
- ☼ Emphasize the importance of chair positions in the chapter

Communication

- ☼ Keep in constant communication with chapter S'ganim; have an active text group chat
- ☼ Send out monthly emails to the NCC S'ganim highlighting successes and other updates regionally and internationally
- ☼ Have biweekly group calls with the chapter S'ganim to check-in, make sure that programming is going smoothly, and for counterparts to bond with each other
- ☼ Have monthly one-on-one calls to work more specifically with each S'ganit
- ☼ Always be there for support

Chairpeople/RLN

- ☼ Work closely with each chapter S'ganit to make chapter-specific chairs that will benefit their chapter the most
- ☼ Keep usage of the council chairpeople and RLN members throughout the year
- ☼ Have calls often with NCC RLN members and council chairs one-on-one to help each chairperson
- ☼ Establish a NCC Siblinghood Chair that would work with the RLN hospitality committee to help to ensure inclusivity during all council and regionwide programming
 - ↪ Would help to create an inclusive environment during conventions
 - ↪ Help to increase siblinghood and bonding between all members
- ☼ Allow Explore Israel chairs and Tikkun Olam chairs to program throughout regional and council events
- ☼ Propose to RLN to keep and expand exploratory committees in order to have members voice their opinions
- ☼ Allow each chair to work with a council board member that fits their chair position the best
