Goals and Ideas:

Small Chapter Convention:

Small chapters and small chapter members have a different experience in BBYO than larger chapters such as the charlotte chapters. Some of these experiences can be made up for through the creation of a small chapter convention to create a stronger base for small chapter to thrive off of. Many times the regional conventions greatly benefit the larger chapters and only marginally affect the small chapters, but this convention aims to change that and create a culture of small chapter strength.

Counterpart Communication and Responsibility:

Under my leadership, counterparts will be responsible for monthly counterpart calls as well as to communication with their assigned partner. This S'gan partner system will create a free flow of ideas and more ideas for carrying out great programming. Partners will be responsible for brief evaluations of each other in order to ensure work effectiveness. S'ganim pairs will be able to plan collectively and bounce ideas off each other.

Creation of a Utilized Program Bank:

I will reorganize the existing program bank to be user friendly and have s'ganim highlight a program on each counterpart call. I hope this method will ensure that s'ganim will search the bank and use the programs. S'ganim will contribute programs built specifically for North Carolina Council.

Methods:

To accomplish the goals I have laid out I will set monthly reminders, ensure constant communication with counterparts, create forms for evaluation of partners, and constantly work through problems as they arise. During counterpart calls I will use evaluation tools such as Stop, Start, Continue (SSC), and comprehensive planning tools to create and enforce goals for counterpart S'ganim.

Programming:

I will ensure innovative programming in NCC. Programming that includes multiple of the five folds will be encouraged, and chapters will be encouraged to apply for Game-Changer Grants to have easy funding for bigger and better programming. Programming needs to keep moving forwards for the return of in-person programming, to keep up with new interests gained over the COVID filled 2020-21. To keep this programming moving forwards the S'ganim will work with their presidents to send out short surveys to their members to gauge interest in programming.
