### letter to NCC BBG

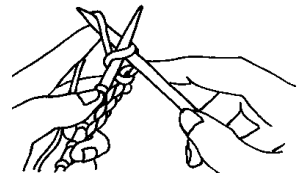
My Sibling BBGs,
