pastries (RECRUITMENT)

- work with each individual chapter to create prospect lists.
 - create goals for recruitment within chapters and the region
 - teach and utilize MRIHA
 - bi-monthly "rush week" recruitment campaign
 - encourage chapters to have their new member meetings at the beginning of the year and host a regional new member meeting at the end of the year
 - work with chapters to reach out to older girls too, not just 8th/9th graders
 - encourage chapters to host new-member-only events with other chapters

cakes (RETENTION)

- work with s'ganit to plan a big/little week leading up to sisterhood overnight
 - create exclusive upperclassmen only events such as an overnight
 - have upperclassmen steer exclusive events to encourage being regionally active even without a title
 - host bbg alumni events
 - teach counterparts how to combat reasons members become inactive
 - BBG monthly spotlight "why my flame still burns"

cookies (RE-EDUCATION)

- make re-education a part of RLTI so that all chapter boards are informed on NSR and BBYO traditions.
 - encourage every chapter to host inductions with a portion on BBYO tradition
 - create a "guide to bbyo" for all members with information about slang, events, and history
 - help counterparts feel comfortable teaching about BBYO in fun and interactive ways

breakfasts (COUNTERPARTS)

- monthly calls with counterparts to discuss progress, challenges, and solutions
 - always be available to all counterparts by text/call
 - teach counterparts how to utilize MRIHA
 - host a bonding event (dinner) to encourage interchapter friends for future meetings
 - keep an active group chat to share our successes and be a support system for each other

- plan more sisterhood-based programs throughout AIT/MIT
